Registration and abstract submission – from the 20th of December 2021. Deadline for abstract submission – the 16th of February 2022. Submission of full paper – the 1st of May 2022. Conference dates – the 16th – 20th of May 2022.

REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION

We kindly ask you to submit applications and full paper drawn up in accordance with the requirements **till the 16th of February** through the personal account on the conference website: https://fizteh.urfu.ru/ru/conference/account/. Previously registered participants can use the existing personal account. Each participant can submit **only one report**. It can be presented orally or as a poster presentation. Nonresident participants can present a report remotely. Absentee participation is possible. If the restrictive measures are extended in May 2022, the conference may be held online. Abstract and article requirements are in the participant's personal account. The conference languages are Russian and English.

The participant registered in the personal account will be the speaker in the future. Therefore, think in advance who will present the report and submit your application and other materials through his personal account.

After the conference full-time participants (who made an oral, poster or remote presentation) can submit their papers for publication in the collection (indexed in the RSCI, UDC, BBK and ISBN will be assigned). Selected works will be published in a separate collection (indexed in Scopus). Article requirements are in the participant's personal account.

The recommended donation amount for undergraduate and master's degree students is 500 rubles, for postgraduate students and young scientists — 1500 rubles. The student's status must be confirmed by a certificate from the place of study, which must be uploaded into the personal account. The student must be a speaker and a part of the writing staff of all submissions (abstracts and articles).
